Minutes of the Affiliation Sub Committee Meeting dated 19.06.2024.14. Resolution no. 17 passed at the 304th meeting of the Governing Council held on 28.01.2025.

PREAMBLE:

In the reference 1st cited, the Government in its G.O. (Ms) No: 458 dated 25.10.1999 Health and Family Welfare (IM1-2) Department, dated has granted 'No Objection Certificate' to R.V.S. Medical Trust, Coimbatore for establishment of an Homoeopathy Medical College and Hospital to conduct BHMS Degree Course with an annual intake of 50 seats.

In the reference 2nd cited, Provisional affiliation was granted on 05.12.2001 to 'R.V.S Homoeopathy Medical College at Sulur, Coimbatore District' for starting BHMS Degree Course with an annual intake of 50 seats from the academic year 2001-2002.

In the reference 3rd cited, appropriate orders of Continuance of Provisional Affiliation were issued to 'R.V.S Homoeopathy Medical College at Sulur, Coimbatore District' for conducting BHMS Degree Course with an annual intake of 50 seats upto the academic year 2017-2018.

An inspection was conducted on 16.08.2018 at the said Institution for the grant of Continuance of Provisional Affiliation for the academic year 2018-2019. After scrutiny of the report, by letter dated 11.10.2019, the above Institution has been informed to submit certain documents for the process of C.P.A for the said academic year. The Institution has remitted fees for the academic year 2018-2019.

In the reference 4th cited, the Ministry of AYUSH, New Delhi by letter dated 10.10.2018 has denied the permission to R.V.S. Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Sulur, Coimbatore for taking admission in I-BHMS Degree course for an intake capacity of 50 seats for the academic year 2018-2019.

As against the denial of permission by the Ministry of AYUSH, New Delhi, the above Institution has filed a Writ Petition No. 28868 of 2018 before the Hon'ble High Court of Madras. However, the above said Institution has not obtained any order to include in the seat matrix for counselling for the academic year 2018-2019. Therefore, the University has not included the name of the said Institution in the seat matrix for I BHMS Degree Course for the academic year 2018-2019.

No students were registered by the University in BHMS Degree Course during the academic year 2018-2019. On 15.03.2023, the petitioner's counsel has sought permission of the Court to withdraw the writ petition and an endorsement to the said effect is also made by the Learned Counsel for the petitioner. Hence, the Hon'ble High Court has dismissed the above writ petition as withdrawn.

During the academic year 2019-2020, an inspection was conducted on 25.07.2019, at the said Institution for the grant of CPA for the academic year 2019-20 and on scrutiny of the report, by letter dated 2.06.2022, the Institution has been informed to submit certain documents for the processing the issue of C.P.A for the said academic year.

In the reference 5th cited, by letter dated 14.06.2019, the Ministry of AYUSH, New Delhi has denied permission to the above Institution to conduct BHMS Degree Course with an intake of 50 seats for the academic year 2019-2020.

As against the denial of Permission by the Ministry of AYUSH, New Delhi, the above Institution has filed a W.P.No. 21207/2019 before the Hon'ble High Court, Madras . The said Writ petition was disposed on 04.10.2019.

Therefore, the University has not included the name of the said Institution in the seat matrix for the academic year 2019-2020. No students were registered by the University in BHMS Degree Course during the academic year 2019-2020.

In the reference 6th cited, by letter dated 1.01.2021, the Ministry of AYUSH, New Delhi has granted permission to the above said Institution to conduct BHMS Degree Course with an annual intake of 50 seats from the academic year 2020-21.

For the academic year 2020-2021, due to covid pandemic, the regular inspection could not be conducted at the affiliated Institution conducting various courses. The Institution submitted an Undertaking, as resolved by the Governing Council.

In the reference 7th cited, by letter dated 11.10.2021, the National Commission for Homoeopathy, New Delhi has granted permission to the said Institution to conduct BHMS with annual intake of 50 seats for the academic year 2021-22.

Due to pandemic, regular Inspection has not been conducted for the academic year 2021-2022 and an agenda has been placed to the Governing council to conduct virtual inspection.

In the reference 8th cited, the Governing Council in its Resolution No.51 passed at the 287th Meeting held on 22.12.2021 has resolved "to issue the orders of Continuance of Provisional Affiliation / Conditional Continuance of Provisional Affiliation to Medical, Dental, AYUSH, Pharmacy, Nursing, Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy and Courses under Allied Health Science stream by conducting inspection through Virtual mode in the first two months of 2022 and to ratify the action of University in having informed the seat matrix to the Selection Committee for the academic year 2021-22".

In the reference 9th cited, by letter dated 26.10.2022, the National Commission for Homoeopathy, New Delhi has granted permission to the said Institution to conduct BHMS Degree Course with an annual intake of 50 seats for the academic year 2022-23.

In the referene 10th cited, in Resolution No.42 passed at the 292nd Governing Council Meeting held on 03.08.2022 it was resolved to grant orders of Continuance of Provisional Affiliation / Conditional Continuance of Provisional Affiliation for the academic year 2022-2023 to those institutions for which relevant Orders of Affiliation has been granted for the academic year 2021-2022 (Based on the data submitted in the Affiliation portal and Virtual Inspection conducted) to conduct Medical, Dental, AYUSH, Nursing, Pharmacy, Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Allied Health Sciences and Post-Doctoral Fellowship Courses as the seat matrix has to be issued to the Selection Committee'

The Principal of the Institution was informed to submit a copy of the upto date digitally authenticated Encumbrance Certificate for the period from 1.10.2023 to till date and Consolidated Sworn Affidavit in INR 200/- NJS paper by earmarking all the survey numbers allotted for all the courses run by the Trust with seal and signature of the Notary public to process the issue of Continuance of Provisional Affiliation Order from the academic year 2018-19 to 2022-23.

In turn, by letter dated 11.09.2024, the Principal has submitted the documents as required by the University.

In the reference 11th cited, by letter dated 24.07.2023, the National Commission for Homoeopathy, New Delhi has granted permission to the said Institution to conduct BHMS degree course with an annual intake of 50 seats for the academic year 2023-24.

On 24.11.2023, the Inspection Commission conducted the Inspection in the above Institution for the academic year 2023-24. The Perusal Committee convened for issue of Continuance of Provisional Affiliation Order for the academic year 2023-24 has recommended to issue Conditional Continuance of Provisional Affiliation Order due to pending submission of DTCP/CMDA approval to the above said Institution. The recommendations of the Perusal Committee has been approved by the Affiliation Sub Committee in its meeting held on 19.06.2024.

The above Institution has remitted all the prescribed fees for issue of Continuance of Provisional Affiliation from the academic year 2018-19 to 2023-24 and aslo fulfilled the norms of the Affiliation Statutes of this University.

In the reference 14th cited, vide resolution no. 17 passed at the 304th meeting of the Governing Council held on 28.01.2025 it was resolved to grant Conditional Continuance of Provisional Affiliation to R.V.S. Homoeopathy Medical College, Coimbatore for conducting BHMS Degree course without admission of students for the academic years 2018-19 and 2019-20 and with an annual intake of 50 seats from the academic years 2020-21 to 2023-24.

ORDER:

In pursuance to the Resolution passed by the Governing Council, inspection report submitted by the Inspection commission and Permission / Conditional permission of the Ministry of AYUSH, National Commission for Indian System of Medicine / National Commission for Homoeopathy New Delhi, minutes of the Affiliation Sub-Committee, the University grants Conditional Continuance of Provisional Affiliation (due to pending submission of DTCP approval) to R.V.S. Homoeopathy Medical College and Hospital, Coimbatore for conducting B.H.M.S Degree Course for the academic years 2018-19 to 2023-2024, subject to:-

- a. fulfill all the requirements (infrastructural, teaching and other facilities available) in the CMS2.0 portal ;
- b. rectify any other deficiencies in the Inspection report of the inspection commission
- c. abide the prescribed Regulations / Guidelines of the National Commission for Homoeopathy, New Delhi / Government of Tamil Nadu and the Affiliation Statutes of the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai issued from time to time;
- d. The University may conduct an inspection to verify the above as and when required and
- e. the usual conditions already intimated in the Provisional Affiliation orders of this University.
